


















What is your experience with Electronic Business Cards?

Members use Outlook:

Outlook contacts

Generally, I'll take the vendor card and email with a follow up to them. I do not normally give out cards.

Primarily use contacts in Office Outlook (so electronic business card/information.

Besides Outlook Contacts, we are looking for way to keep contact list for sourcing and leadership that entire team can access vs it being tied to an individual outlook account

Syncing Outlook Contacts to my iphone

I always get business cards and keep them in an effort to enter all of them into my email contacts THEN get rid of them. ...

Some interesting electronic options:

CamCard

I have downloaded an add-on app for Outlook that searches for signature lines and then help to auto build or update contacts. Electronically input them into contacts Use electronic business cards and import the information into our CRM system. I use camcard which downloads directly to my outlook accounts ScanBizCard allows you to take a picture from your smartphone and it automatically imports the information into your contacts and retains a copy of the picture too.

Tool that scrapes email for net new signatures. Tool that captures picture of card and translates to vCard. Tool that airdrops vCards to iPhone and Android.

I capture business card information into Evernote and link the card with other record entries I keep in Evernote.

And some other perspectives:

I feed all info from a paper card into a contact manager (currently Outlook/exchange server) I would prefer to go digital, but cards are easier to exchange quickly at a conference and input important data later. a single electronic format is not likely. Open to it I don't move between organizations very often,

so I don't need to port my contacts between organizations very often, organizations very often.

We keep some customer contact details in excel, Sales Force and in personal address books.
